Ten students from DRS International participated in the Model United Nation Conference at HPS. Vishnu, Roshan Sonalika, Apoorva, Simran, Mitali, , Seemantini, Nihal, David, Peter, were the delegates of various countries such as; Gabon, Sri Lanka and Ethiopia. They made their presence felt among the congregation of 227 delegates.

In ECOSOC the delegates were able to discuss the global issue of migrant workers. In Human Rights Commission the agenda of legalizing Euthanasia was discussed. IAEA debated on the technical issues such as nuclear dependency in future. They were alarmed by the recent nuclear disasters however no one gave up nuclear dependency.

The Security Council being the most important body of the United Nation with few members discussed about the Middle East uprising and its effect on Libya. General Assembly with representatives of 66 countries was the biggest conglomeration of delegates who discussed the lack of physical and social infrastructure in middle income countries. Delegates completed the drafting of 9 resolutions of which seven resolutions were passed.
